We are witnessing a potential turning point in world history. The American social and political model-mass production and consumption relying on fossil fuels-has run its course, but no alternative model has yet emerged to take its place. Why do such profound ruptures occur in global affairs, and how might they be resolved?

Mary Kaldor introduces a new concept, "experimental junctures," to account for what happens when political institutions are out of kilter with far-reaching economic, social, and technological change. In these times of existential crisis, political leaders must act, but their frameworks for action are out of date. Instead, they experiment with ideas drawn from outside their ranks-some with disastrous consequences, others potentially able to command a new long-term consensus.

Putting forward a theory of political innovation that foregrounds social movements, Kaldor shows that during experimental junctures, the political class borrows from civil society. She warns that if political leaders today do not embrace democratic experimentalism and transform institutions at all levels, the prognosis could be a catastrophic world war. A capstone work from a major scholar of political authority and violence, *Experimental Junctures* makes a timely case for the emergence of a new global order after American hegemony.

After several decades of unprecedented growth that turned China into the world's second largest economy, today China is facing major economic challenges, exacerbated by rising tariffs imposed by its most important export market, the United States. How can we explain the extraordinary rise and sudden faltering of China's economic miracle?

Kent Deng takes a long-term view, charting the development of China's economy from the nineteenth century to the present day. He shows that the policies implemented during Mao's rule from the 1950s to the 1970s led to a growth cul-de-sac with major economic disincentives and mass poverty. This forced Mao's successor, Deng Xiaoping, to reform and open up China's economy with a view to unleashing the economic power of the market. The new model developed by Deng Xiaoping combined state-led import dependency with exports in order to catch up with the West, and success in achieving exports depended on a unique combination of cheap labour, cheap land and low environmental protection which, taken together, gave China an absolute advantage in the global market, enabling it to produce goods very cheaply and export them to Western countries where the costs were much higher. But Deng's economic model is now facing increasing resistance from those countries on which China has relied for its export growth. Since 2010, two doors have been closing on China: the door for goods heading for China (vital for China's modernization) and the door for goods coming from China (vital for paying for China's imports). This is likely to end China's hitherto uninterrupted 'import-export combo' loop. The 2025 tariff war between United States and China is only the most recent manifestation of this new state of affairs in the global economy.

Given the headwinds China now faces, and given that many low-income countries have now modelled themselves on China and begun to supply the world market with low-priced goods, China would need an economic miracle to bounce back to its pre-2010 growth trajectory.





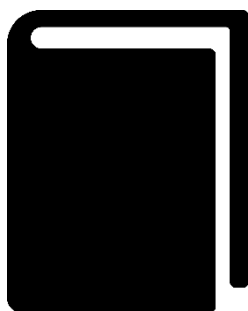

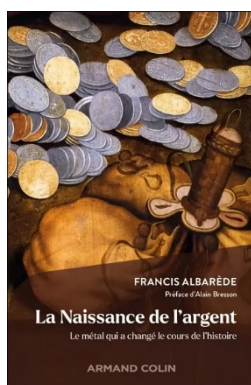

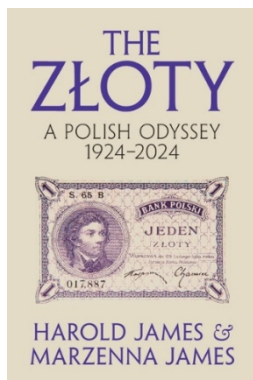

The Zloty draws on recently available Polish archival material from central banks and international institutions to show how long-lived debates about inflation have been central in Polish political history. It offers surprising revelations about the drama of the evacuation and legal treatment of the central bank's gold after the German invasion of 1939 and the long struggle for economic and monetary reform while Poland was part of the Soviet system, going back to the late 1950s. It includes interwar and post-1990 sections that give an exemplary case of how a country on the periphery of the international economic system tried hard to integrate, ultimately failing in the first instance, while succeeding with dramatic success over the past thirty-five years. 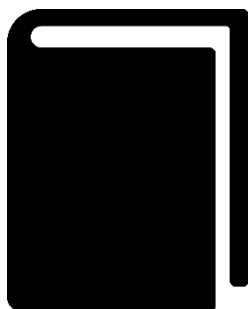

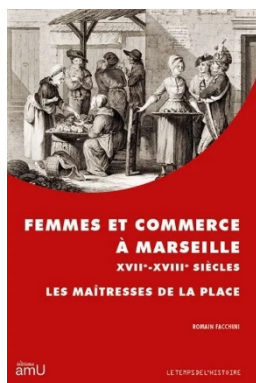

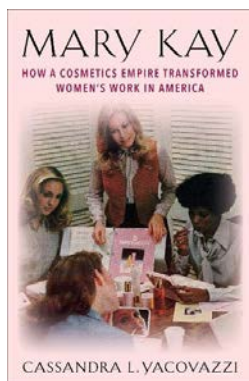

When Mary Kay Ash founded her company, Beauty by Mary Kay, in 1963, women had limited options in a male-dominated business world. By the 1970s, the cosmetics and skincare company had a salesforce of tens of thousands and became the first woman-founded firm listed on the New York Stock Exchange. Mary Kay and the pink Cadillac turned into cultural icons, and the company remains a billion-dollar global business. Often dismissed as a lipstick-selling side hustle or labeled a predatory multilevel marketing scheme, Mary Kay drove a major and surprising shift in women's economic opportunities outside the office.

This book tells the story of Mary Kay Ash and the cosmetics firm that bears her name, from its founding and growth to the distinctive gendered corporate culture she cultivated. Ash combined direct sales and multilevel marketing strategies with workplace flexibility, a rhetoric of "be your own boss," and a sense of community and recognition for American women as they entered the workplace. She monetized women's social networks and fostered a lifestyle brand built on values of faith, family, and free enterprise. Cassandra L. Yacovazzi explores how women in Mary Kay have navigated opportunity, structural constraints, and shifting gender norms, showing how they are sometimes empowered and sometimes exploited. She also considers Mary Kay Ash's complex personal life and carefully constructed public image, simultaneously a maternal icon and a driven executive. In this nuanced view of Mary Kay that elevates the voices of the women who participated, we find new insights into the history of the beauty industry, female entrepreneurship, and women's work in the United States.





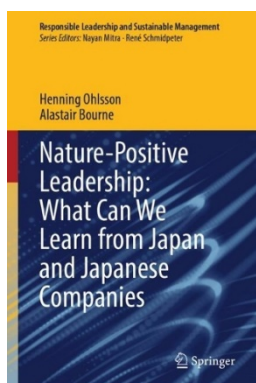

This book is a journey of transformation of companies. And a journey through the mountains and nature. Over the centuries, Japanese culture has developed a deep respect for natural systems. It is a must-read for companies struggling to maintain a positive balance sheet and remain sustainable at the same time, in the backdrop of climate crisis and mitigating regulations.



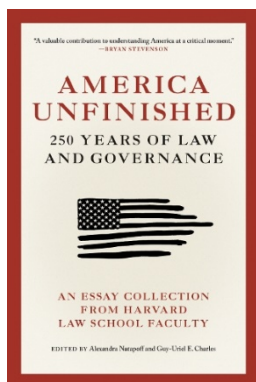

Political Communications is a now established series of eleven books, the first of which appeared in the aftermath of the watershed General Election of 1979. Cumulatively the series offers unique insights from both practitioner and academic perspectives with commentaries from those responsible for organizing, reporting, and analyzing every campaign held during the last 45 years. The primary focus of the books is to understand the interplay between the rival parties, various media and the voting public, and the similarities and differences between this and previous elections.

This book resembles previous volumes in terms of its structure. The content will, however, differ not least because this election ended in the return of a new government. Political Communication in Britain (2024) will provide commentaries from party insiders about a campaign whose outcome was

seemingly not in doubt, but which nonetheless delivered some surprising results due to the idiosyncrasies of the UK electoral system. The book will examine the workings and efforts of various rival campaign, both online and off, in the context of a hastily called election held in July for the first time since 1945. The reporting of events and role of journalism in seeking to hold the rival politicians will be discussed including by those responsible for delivering some of the most popular news coverage. A range of polling experts will examine how voters experienced the campaign through use of quantitative and qualitative based forms of analysis to provide insights into why and how so many different parties were able to gain the necessary support to secure representation in the House of Commons. Aside from Labour, the other beneficiaries from this campaign were the Liberal Democrats, Reform UK, the Greens, and a range of independents: the reasons for their successes will be complemented by explorations of why the Conservatives and Scottish Nationalists succumbed to such heavy defeats.





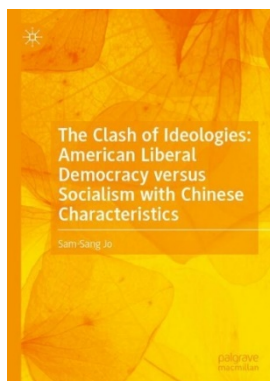

By tracing the trajectories of American liberal democracy and socialism with Chinese characteristics, the book situates contemporary rivalry within a broader theory of ideological cycles and world revolution. Drawing on the Lasswellian concept of world revolution, it characterizes the present era as one defined by fragmentation, contestation, and normative uncertainty—an interregnum in which neither model nor ideology commands uncontested hegemony. Through an integrated theoretical and historical framework, the book moves beyond diagnosing the current crisis of international order to recalibrate prevailing conceptual frameworks and expand the analytical horizons through which its structural transformation is interpreted and assessed by scholars, journalists, and policymakers alike.



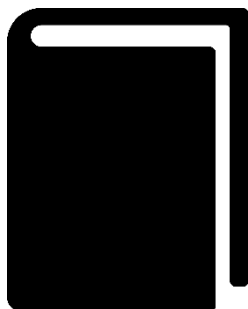

Bad Refugees examines a troubling discrepancy at the heart of refugee humanitarianism: some forced migrants become celebrated, welcomed, and instantly legible as "deserving," while others are cast as "bad", imposters, enemies, and opaque mysteries. Who counts as a refugee worth caring for? Who slips beneath our moral radar? Why does our attention focus on a few while the majority remain unseen? Bringing together conflict sociology, geopolitical analysis, and comparative history, this book argues that refugee recognition is far from a humanitarian response to suffering. It is a geopolitical process of exclusion and stigmatization. In a world of ever-increasing forced migration, the challenge of our generation becomes to understand clearly, and act ethically with, people in mortal danger. The tragedy of refugee discourse today is not indifference, but selective compassion and blindspots. *Bad Refugees* shows how we got here, and how to think, see, and respond differently.



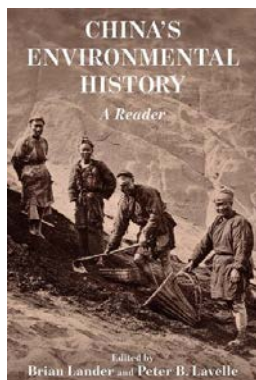

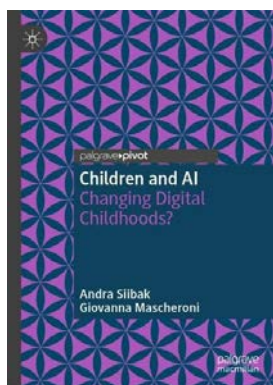

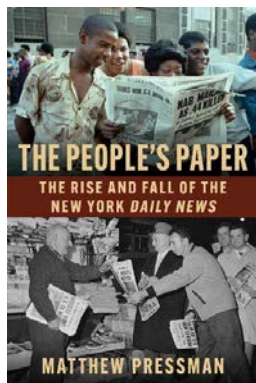

When the *New York Daily News* launched in 1919, it didn't just sell papers—it reinvented them. 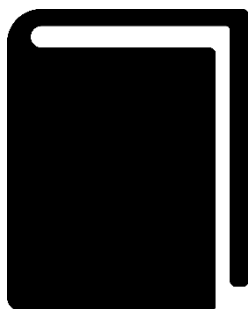

Study of the Late Bronze to Early Iron Age transition in the Aegean has bloomed since the 1980s. *Heavy Metals* adds to the increasingly rich intellectual milieu of work on this topic by reassessing an often overlooked question. What impact, if any, did the adoption of iron metallurgy have on life in the Aegean around the start of the Iron Age?

Sarah Murray offers a re-evaluation of iron metallurgy's position in Early Iron Age Aegean economies and societies, engaging with the question of iron's role in Aegean society in two ways. 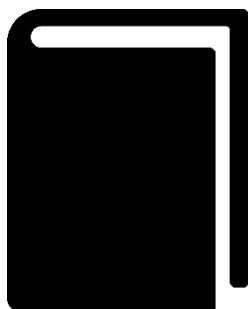

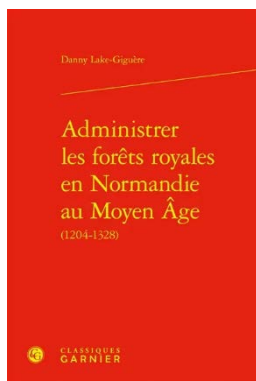
